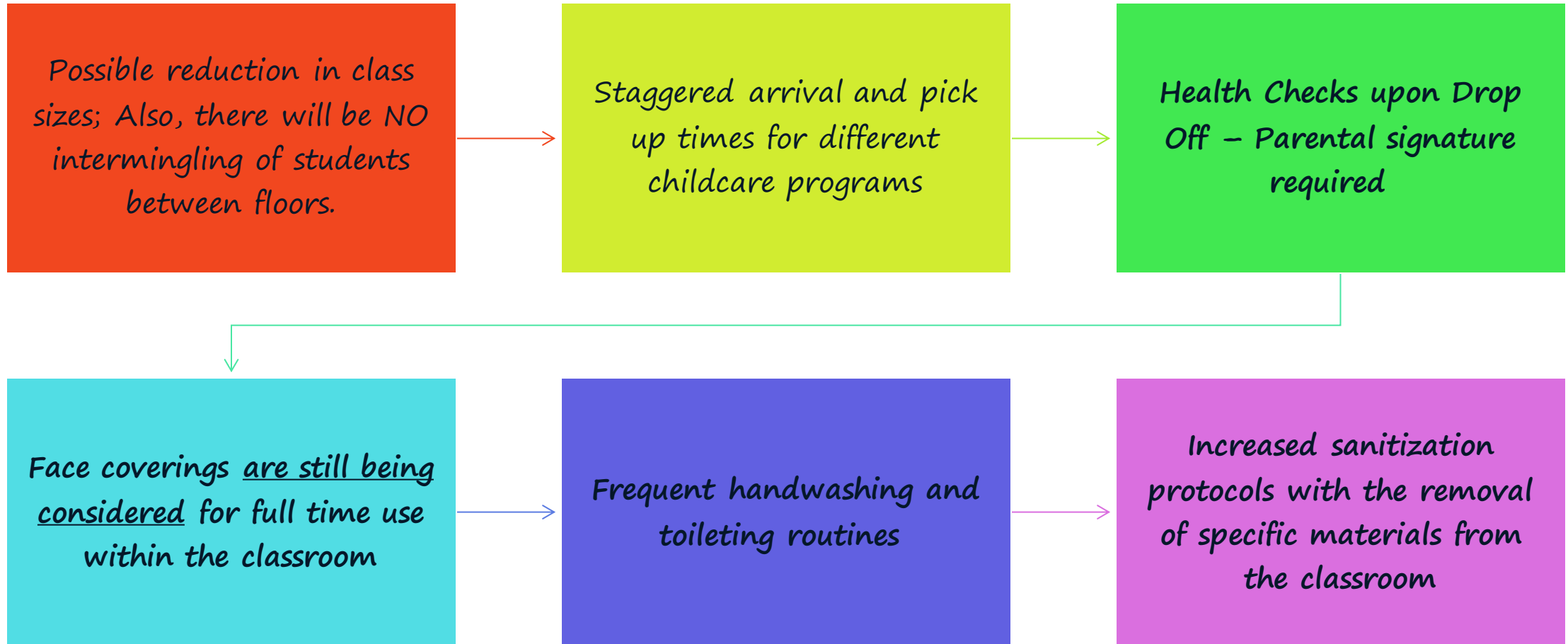

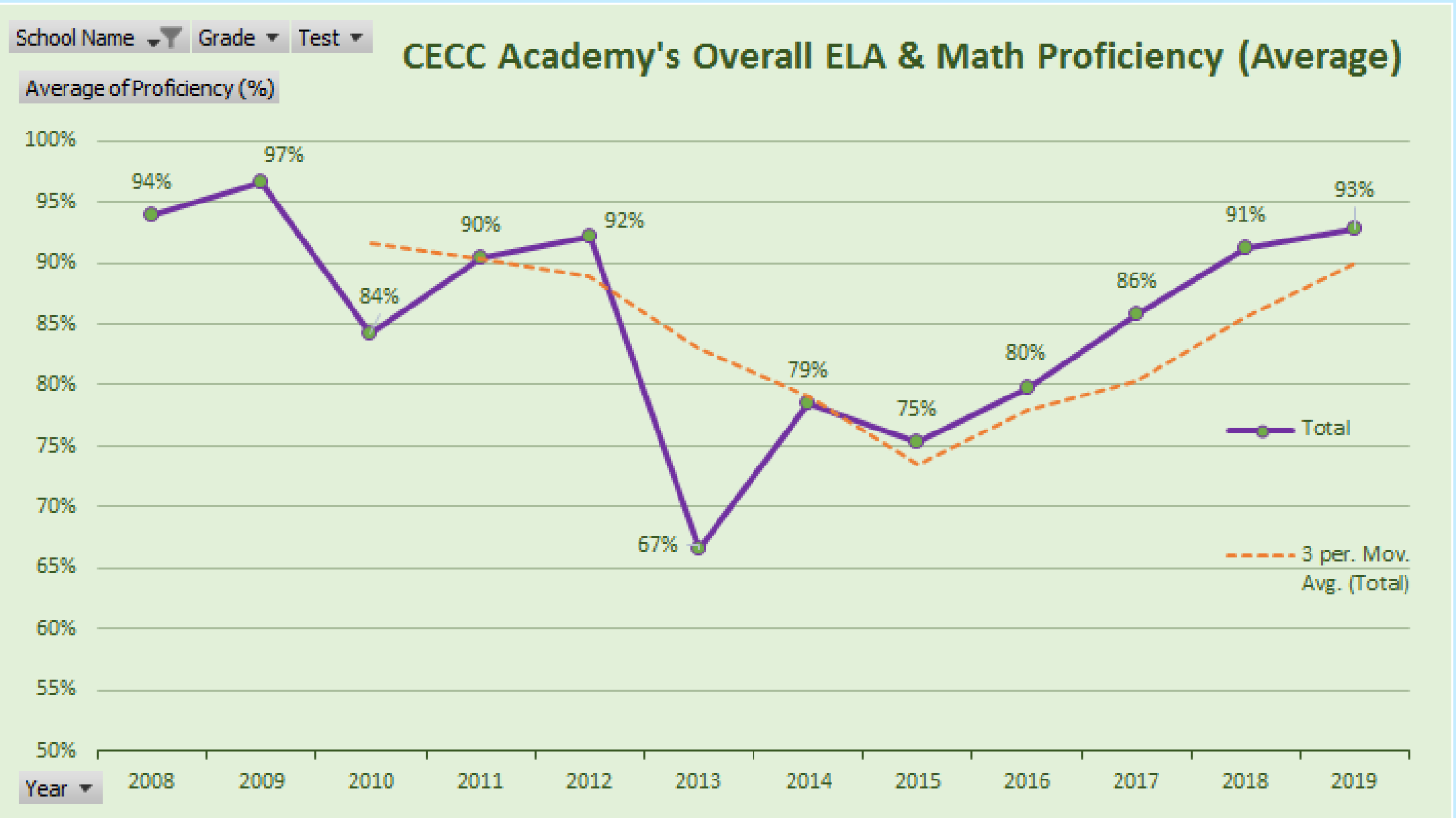

- Application for Admission
- Parent Supplemental Information Form
- Updated Physical w/ Immunization Records
- Cumulative Health Record
- CACFP Eligibility Forms for Meals (Both Sides)
- Emergency Contact Card
- Performing Arts (Program temporarily suspended for 20-21)



# How Do I Secure My Child's Seat? Cont...

## Additional Health Requirements:

- Complete a Health Declarations Form.
- All Children attending CECC must take the COVID-19 Antibodies test before the start of school. Consult with your child's pediatrician.
